

CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD



PURPOSE

The children are called out of the main assembly for the Liturgy of the Word with their catechist. They listen to one or more of the same Scripture readings heard in the main Assembly but in the simple approved version for Liturgy with Children. Catechists serve as readers and facilitators of a dialogue homily to help the children grow in their understanding of being a disciple of Jesus. As they return to their parents for the Liturgy of the Eucharist, they receive a Children's bulletin to share with their family about the Scripture message of the day.

REQUIREMENTS

- Desire to share the Word with children.
- Willingness to participate in training and quarterly meetings.
- Teens may participate with an Adult catechist, to share the Word and lead Prayer
- Virtus training for adults prior to working with children is provided and required.

FREQUENCY

- The Liturgy of the Word with Children takes place during the academic year during the Sunday 9 am Mass, except holidays and academic break weeks.

TIME COMMITMENT

- Individual preparation time as needed.
- Attend group catechist meetings.
