



LETTER OF REQUEST

A letter to request the Sacrament of Confirmation is to be written to our Pastor. It is his responsibility to present you to the Bishop and recommend you as a prepared candidate for the Sacrament of Confirmation. Part of his recommendation will be based on the result of his interview with you. Part of his recommendation will be on the word of your catechists. The other part of his recommendation will be based on what you tell him in your letter of request.

This letter should be well written and should contain reasons as to why our Pastor should recommend that you receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. Some suggestions for content include: why you decided to complete your initiation at this time; various projects you have undertaken as a sign of your service to the community; why you value being a Catholic and how your faith has helped you to be a good person. You might also mention your hopes and dreams as a young Catholic trying to follow the model of Jesus Christ. There are many possible things you can include in your letter. Only you can decide what is best for you and what will best present your case.

This letter should be written to our Pastor and it should be in the form of a letter and put in a sealed envelope. It should be given to Lisa Mersereau who will pass it along to our Pastor.
